[1] Announcement

Coleraine & District Motor Club Ltd Kart Section will organise a **Clubman Bambino & Short Circuit Interclub Class** One race for class one and bambino karts on Sat 2nd Aug with testing on Fri 1st from 12.00noon-6.00pm at the NW200 Paddock Circuit. The event shall count as round 2 of the NI Karting Championship for class one and bambinos only.

No cycling, playing ball or animals & Pets are permitted either in the pits or at the circuit.

[13] TELEVISION COVERAGE

The event shall not be televised

[14] AWARDS

AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AS FOLLOWS: -

Trophies shall be awarded for 1st,2nd & 3rd based on the result of the FINAL race, awards will be presented approximately 30 min after the final race. Trophies will be awarded in the NI Karting Championship to best Rookie in each class. Prize giving area will be outside close to where drivers briefing takes place.
