This Licence can be revoked at any time and without notice.

At all ACU Permitted events the Chief Steward, the Clerk of the Course and the Incident Officer, immediately prior to commencement of Official Practice **MUST** verify that the course fully complies with all the conditions - safety barriers, protective devices, etc as per the most recent Track Inspection Report.

See Articles 8.10 and 8.11 of the ACU National Sporting Code concerning alterations to courses.

If any alterations are proposed by the circuit owner, an application must be made to the ACU Road Race Drag & Sprint Committee for approval. In such a case a further inspection by the approved ACU Track Inspector is required.

CONDITIONS OF ISSUE:

1. That all competitors are subject to the National Sporting Code of the ACU.
2. That the requirements of the ACU Road Race Committee in respect of the organisation of motorcycle race meetings and speed events are complied with. Should an unauthorised event be held on any licensed course or adjacent area, this licence shall have no effect and the ACU may decline to issue any further licence.
3. That any special course rules specified below, and any other requirements of the ACU Road Race Committee, are observed.
4. No permanent alterations may be made to the course unless approved by the ACU Road Race Committee. (Articles 8.10 and 8.11 ACU NSC also refers.)
5. This course is licensed for circuit racing / speed events with a maximum number of starters for a mass start (as detailed on page 2).
