Supplementary Regulations



1. **Announcement:** Knockhill Motor Sports Club will organise National & Interclub Sprints on Saturday 12th & Sunday 13th September 2026 at Knockhill Race Circuit, By Dunfermline, Fife. The Event will be held under the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport UK (the "ASN") (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any Official Documents the Organising Club may issue for the Event. Please read the Official Documents issued to you for each Event. The Organiser reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event or any part thereof. In this event the Competitor or Entrant has no right to claim against the Organiser in respect of any loss or expense they may thereby incur.
2. **Authorisation:** Motorsport UK Speed-Sprint National & Interclub permits have been applied for.
3. **Championship and Eligibility:** The event is a round of the 2026 Woodford Trailers Motorsport UK HSA British Sprint Championship & The WSCC 7s Speed Series Championship. The event is open to members of the Hillclimb & Sprint Association, Westfield Sports Car Club and Knockhill Motor Sports Club and all registered contenders in the above championships.
4. **Licences:** Competitors must produce valid and appropriate competition licences and championship cards.
5. **The Course:** The course is approximately 2.3 miles long on tarmac with left and right hand corners. The course is run in an anti-clockwise direction, starting in the pit lane and the finish line will be denoted by chequered boards at Leslies (after 1.75 laps). All competitors will be given the opportunity of 1 practice and 2 timed runs each day, time and weather permitting.
6. **Signing On, Scrutineering & Event Timetable:** All competitors must complete the Signing On Declaration online prior to the event. Specific times for on-event Scrutineering, Practice & Timed runs will be published in the Final Instructions.
7. **The event will consist of classes as follows:-**
 - BSC** Registered competitors in the 2026 Woodford Trailers Motorsport UK HSA British Sprint Championship
 - WSCC** Registered competitors in the 2026 WSCC 7s Speed Series Championship
 - KMSC** Members of the Organising Club
8. **Practice and Starting:** Competitors will be permitted to walk the course before 8.15 am and will be given the opportunity of one practice run; Practice runs need not be timed. Starting order will be determined by number order. Cars will start singly. The method of timing is electrical, and triggered by breaking light beams at the start and finish line. The start signal will be green light. A red light indicates that the course is not open. Timing struts are compulsory (NCR Ch.14 App.4 Art.11).
9. **Numbers:** Competitors are responsible for providing and fitting competition number in accordance with NCR Ch.14 App.5 Art.5. Numbers must be displayed on both sides of the car at all times. For double entered cars it is the competitors responsibility for ensuring the correct number is displayed at all times.
10. **Tyre Warming:** There will be NO tyre warming at this event.
11. **Noise:** Noise emissions will be monitored during the Event and Vehicles may be required to undergo noise testing in compliance with NCR Ch.7 App.8.
12. **Entry process:** Entries should be submitted online at <https://knockhill.alphatiming.co.uk/> Entries close on 23:59 on Friday 4th September 2026. There will be maximum of 20. All entries must be made on the official entry form. The entry fee is £300 which included use of the Pitlane Garages.
 - Entry fees will only be refunded as follows:-
 - a) Notification of withdrawal in writing before closing date = Full refund.
 - b) Notification of withdrawal in writing after closing date and before 5pm on Wednesday 9th September 2026 entry fee less a maximum of £50 administration charge.
 - c) If the meeting is cancelled or postponed for any reason the organisers reserve the right to retain a sum not exceeding £50 of each entry fee.
