[1] Announcement

Bishopscourt Kart Club Ltd will organise an interclub event for short circuit race for class one karts, Clubman event for bambino karts & interclub event for long circuit superkart classes.

[2] Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the Motorsport UK National Competition Rules (NCR) (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations.

[8.1] BAMBINO GEARING FOR BISHOPSCOURT RACE CIRCUIT GEARING CAN BE CHANGED, GEARING PERMITTED 10 TOOTH FRONT SPROCKET ALONG WITH 78, 79 OR 80 REAR SPROCKET. APART FROM THIS CHANGE ALL CLASSES WILL COMPETE IN ACCORDANCE WITH MOTORSPORT UK NCRs.

[9] VEHICLES STARTING POSITIONS

STARTING POSITIONS HEAT 1 WILL BE BASED ON QUALIFYING

STARTING POSITIONS HEAT 2 WILL BE BASED ON RESULT RACE 1

POINTS GAINED ON HEAT 1 & 2 FORM THE FINAL GRID (*SUPERKART HEAT 3 GRID WILL BE BASED ON HEAT 2 RESULT*)

[11] POINTS

Points will awarded to all classified finishers in each race, as stated in NCR Ch.18 App.7 Art1.10 with competitors taking the start & finishing flag of each race.

[12] PRACTICING REQUIREMENTS

PRACTICING WILL only be on the morning of the event with each competitor must complete a mandatory 3 laps.

[13] Identification

Identification numbers will be issued through NIKA Registration for all Drivers, and all drivers must be registered before competing at this event.

[14] PITS AREA

No cycling, playing ball or animals & Pets are permitted either in the pits or at the circuit.

[15] TELEVISION COVERAGE

The event might be televised

[16] AWARDS

AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AS FOLLOWS: -

Trophies for NI Championship shall be awarded for 1st, 2nd & 3rd based on points accumulated over all races for all short circuit & long circuit classes, Trophies for BSRC shall be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd highest points scorers accumulated over the 3 F125 Superkart Long Circuit races, Trophies for **NIGP** based on the final Race in each Class for all short circuit & long circuit classes, Trophies will be presented approximately 30 min after the final race. Prize giving area will be at the base of the commentary tower. **PLEASE NOTE Class 1 Classes will receive an NIGP Winners Trophy only & All Superkarts will receive an NIGP Winners Trophy & Plate that can be used within the UK.**

[17] ENTRIES

THE MAXIMUM ENTRY FOR THE MEETING IS 100 AFTER THIS WE WILL PREPARE A RESERVED LIST AND ALLOCATE IN THE EVENT OF ENTRIES BEING WITHDRAWN; THE MINIMUM ENTRY WILL BE 40. SHOULD ANY OF THE ABOVE FIGURES NOT BE REACHED, THE ORGANISERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO AMALGAMATE CLASSES OR CANCEL THE EVENT. ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED FROM BKC MEMBERS ONLY.

[29] Parc Fermé

There shall be 1 Parc Fermé and should be accessed immediately when returning to the pits after racing, please note only the competitors of the race are allowed in Parc Fermé and a competitor can be disqualified from results if he or she gets assistance or has contact with any 3rd party. In Parc Fermé all competitors must follow and take instruction from the scrutineer's.

[30] Judicial Procedure

In accordance with Section C of the current Motorsport NCRs, 2019 CIK FIA Judicial Trial, Appendix 1 of these Regulations and Karting UK Supplementary Regulations.

[31] Race & Respect

By entering this event all competitors, and their associates, commit to the **Motorsport UK Race'n' Respect** campaign and agree to positively promote and demonstrate the Racing Code, which is appended to these regulations.

[32] Other Requirements/Information

TYRES: Each competitor will be eligible to register dry weather tyres on their Alpha Garage for Sat 5th June 2026 Race Day which can be either new or used tyres. Only registered tyres can be used at this event.

Additional requirements and information shall be detailed on the circuit notice board and advised at drivers briefing on the morning of the event.
