

Super One Series 31st May & 1st June 2025 Clay Pigeon Supplementary Regulations

1. The Super One Series Ltd will organise Round 5 and 6 on 31st May & 1st June 2025 at Clay Pigeon for Comer C50, MightE, IAME M1, Honda Cadet GX200, IAME Waterswift Restricted, Micro Max, Honda R200, Inter Max, IAME Waterswift, Junior Max, Senior Max and 177 Max.

2. Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the 2025 Sporting Regulations of Super One Series Ltd and these Supplementary Regulations.

3. Eligibility

The event is open to all fully-elected members of Registered drivers of the Super One Series.

All entrants must produce a club membership card/Super One Licence.

Class Regulations as per Super One Series General Regulations.

4. Championships

The event is 2 rounds of the Super One Series.

5. Scrutineering/Programme

Online Scrutineering declaration and details to be submitted before Time Qualifying.

6. Event Start

The event will start at 09:30 hrs and 10:00 hrs on Sunday.

Nature of start: Official Practice or Timed Qualifying

Any competitor not signed on by 09:30 hrs Saturday may be excluded.

7. Description of Event

There will be Official testing, timed qualifying and two heats and a final.

The track measures 815 metres and the number of corners is 8, the surface is tarmac.

The following classes will apply: Comer C50, MightE, IAME M1, Honda Cadet GX200, IAME Waterswift Restricted, Micro Max, Honda R200, Inter Max, IAME Waterswift, Junior Max, Senior Max and 177 Max.

8. Vehicles Starting Positions

TQ grid positions will be in Championship order.

Rolling starts. Comer C50 & IAME M1 & MightE standing starts.

9. Practice Requirements

Practicing will be a minimum of one 6 minute session.

10. Identification

Official Approved Super One Numbers only to be used. Numbers must be displayed on all 4 sides of the kart whilst on circuit.

11. Pits Area

Entry to the circuit is from Thursday from 09:00 hrs.

No pit bikes, push bikes, model cars, footballs, roller skates or similar in the pits. Ball games in the pits or on the circuit are not allowed. All drivers remember you are responsible for all persons connected with you. You may be excluded from the meeting if this regulation is not complied with.

It is forbidden to damage property, including new facilities, crops or surrounding area which include pegging down awnings or washing down engine and karts with combustible or hazardous materials.

The running of karts and their engines is NOT permitted in the pits unless in an area designated by the Scrutineer.

In case of emergency, your fire extinguisher must be easily accessible by any member of your team.

12. Judges of Fact

All Officials are Judges of Fact.

13. Filming

14. Awards

Awards will be presented as follows: As per Championship Regulations.

15. Entries

The maximum entry for classes is 34 and the minimum is 15. Should any of these figures not be reached the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or cancel that class at this event. If a class has 75% or less capacity, grids may be mixed with another class.

16. Entry List

All entries must be made online on the Super One Alpha System.

17. Entry Fee

The entry fee is £189.00 for Saturday and Sunday. No refunds are given. Optional Friday Practice £75.00
