HKRC NOVEMBER 2025 CLUB MEETING ROUND 10

Please take time to read the following important information as it is for everyone's benefit taking part.

We must also remind you that No Scooters, Bikes, Footballs etc are to be brought on site.

Until essential works are carried out in the willows paddock. Please Park sensibly on site and only use the room you need to allow for others. We must remind you that booked pit bays in the main paddock are for working vehicles only and if you are with a team, you must unload and park behind tree line or around the willows if room. Do not block roadways or walkways or reserved pit bays as this will result in less time on track waiting for people to move.

IMPORTANT CHANGE FOR THE WINTER MONTHS ON TRACK START TIME IS NOW 9.30AM UNTIL MARCH.

THIS MONTH IS ALSO REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY SO THERE WILL BE A BREAK NEAR TO 10.55AM TO ALLOW YOU TO GATHER ON START/FINISH.

Please make sure you are organised with all the appropriate paperwork, licences, Parent/ Guardian etc. when checking in on SATURDAY morning. PLEASE NOTE START TIME FOR BOTH DAYS WILL BE 9.30AM.

To Check in on Saturday for practice and if not doing practice day. Please make sure you have signed on, online.

Timetable of Events

- **Friday 7th (Set up day)**
 - **Gates will open from 10:30**
 - Flood lights will be switched off from 22:00 or maybe sooner.
 - Anyone arriving after lights off must park on grass area near gate house and wait until staff arrive on Saturday morning or park around the willows on the other side of circuit. **Please do not park in a pit bay in the main paddock unless you have booked it. When parking up please park sensibly to allow enough room for everyone and Ambulance access. There is no access to the track on set up day. Anyone found Parking in someone's pit bay will be moved.**
- **Saturday 8th (Practice Day)**
 - Clubhouse open from 07:30 for checking in and practice sticker & wristband allocation.
 - First Practice will commence at 09.30 First group to be on grid for 09:20
- **SUNDAY 9th (Race Day)**
 - Clubhouse open from 07:30 for checking in (only for those not attending on Friday)
 - Driver's briefing will be held on start finish line at approx. 08.45. Please remember it is mandatory for all drivers, PG license holders and team entrants to attend. At the discretion of the clerk of the course roll calls will be taken to ensure attendance.
 - Practice and Racing will commence at 09.30 each day. First session to be on grid for 09.20.

Parking / Paddock Safety

- **The main paddock area is exclusively for use by people with a pre-booked pit bays. Please do not park in one if you haven't booked it or found out from the club if it is available. Some people with annual pit bays only do the race day and turn up Friday afternoon or Saturday morning.** Additional pit space is available in the area around turn 1 and behind the willows. **For weekend Pit Bay availability please email hkrc.pitbays@gmail.com.**
- Only working vehicles are permitted in the paddock area and all working vehicles **MUST** be parked within the confines of your pit space.
- Annual pit bay holders please ensure you have collected from Race control and always display your pit pass.
- The roadways within the paddock area must be always kept clear to allow for emergency access. If at any time during the day a roadway is blocked the event will be stopped and will not resume until the roadway is clear. Please make sure you always park considerately.
- All other vehicles and spectator vehicles must be parked sensibly in the parking area to the right of the main gate along the tree line. At all times obeying any instructions given by HKRC officials.
- **We are now taking bookings for 2026 Annual Pit Bays for those of you that wish to keep for next year. We ask that these are paid for on or before our December meeting, after which will go on general sale. Please go to race control if you wish to reserve.**

Signing On

- **Signing on will need to be completed via your Alpha account prior to the event.**
- Please ensure that your licence photographs are uploaded to your Alpha profile.
- Please ensure that your PG Licence and photographs are uploaded to your Alpha profile.
- All competitors and PG license holders will need to check in with race control on practice day.
- Anyone not checked in by 08.45 on SUNDAY that wasn't at practice will be withdrawn from the meeting.
- Keep an eye on emails from us on your Alpha account as these will be updates for the race weekend.

Scrutineering

Saturday

Tyre bar codes will also need to be scanned during SATURDAY.

Please take your tyres down to scrutineering for scanning during the day on Saturday.

Slick & Wet Tyres from nominated classes (Classes will be displayed on the notice board) are to be left in Scrutineering Tyre Bay once scanned. All Drivers that are present on Saturday must scan tyres before final practice session on track finishes, Thank you

This month will be CADET CLASSES, ROTAX MINI INTER AND JUNIOR ROTAX MUST ALSO NOMINATE ONE SET OF WETS TO BE SCANNED FOR THE MEETING AND PLACED IN THE TYRE BAY.

- Our scrutineering team will be conducting safety checks during SATURDAY. If they have not seen your kart, please let them know so they can complete the check.
- Scrutineering forms all classes must be completed on the Alpha system. These forms **MUST** be completed by 08.45 on SUNDAY. If for any reason you have difficulty completing, please see our Chief Scrutineer before 08.45 SUNDAY morning.
- **Can you please attach your transponders for the last 2 sessions on Saturday for checks.**
- **Last month we trialled traffic light system for nosecone checks please remain seated when red light is on and wait for green light before getting out.**



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General

- Format for all classes 2 Heats, and a Final.
- **ALL CLASSES AS PER NCR 2025 REGULATIONS.**
- Scales will be closed during the practice session on Sunday morning. If you wish to weigh you can do so before your practice commences.
- At all times whilst on site please follow the instructions given by HRKC or Motorsport UK officials.
- Engines can be started in the Assembly Area **NO** excessive revving. **Failure to obey this instruction will result in being reported to the Steward of the Meeting.** We would prefer if you started engines on the dummy grid once kart is on the ground to help the club keep the neighbours happy. Or unless you have permission from the Chief Scrutineer to do otherwise.
- Please be respectful to our neighbours in the surrounding villages. Please keep to the speed limit.
- Dogs must be kept securely within your awning space and **must not** be walked in the fields surrounding the track, on the track or in the paddock area. The only place to walk your dog is outside the paddock towards the road gate.
- Please make sure that you are always aware of the clubs' supplementary regulations.
- **Track walks are only permitted Saturday and Sunday morning prior to practice and racing.**

Rubbish bins will be situated in the cages around the main paddock these will be the main point where rubbish from the weekend can be left, we will have someone going around with bin bags for you which can be left outside your awning during the day or placed in the collection point. If you are missed, please call in at Race Control and ask for one. DO NOT leave tyres at the circuit.

- Beware of the land drains around willows they have been there for a while now markers are in place.
- During busy months Entries will be available to members first for 10 days. Entries open on a Monday preceding the last meeting.
- Please note if there are any updates to this information it will be posted on the noticeboard in the clubhouse or via social media.
- May we remind you that anyone reported, seen or caught tampering or damaging any part of HKRC site will be dealt with accordingly. Everyone that visits must treat all facilities with respect.
- **PLEASE KEEP TOILETS CLEAN AND TIDY i.e. CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF WHEN USING HAND BASINS AND CUBICLES ITS FOR EVERYONES BENEFIT.**
- **POTALOOS ARE SITUATED AROUND THE SITE.**
- **Any additional information will be sent to you via your alpha account or hkrc app.**
