



The UK Kart Series 2026 Championship returns to Llandow for Round 7.

Camping over is available on the Friday & Saturday evenings. The Paddock will be open for access as follows

Access from 7am – 10pm Gate will be locked outside of these times, if you need access outside these hours for emergency's then the key holder details can be found below.

The Key Holder / emergency contact for this round is James Drabwell from Team Momentum he can be reached on 07897669955. But this is to be used ONLY in an emergency.

They have also asked us to remind you that you must take all your tyres home with you. Anyone caught dumping tyres will face big penalty's.

As always please be respectful and keep the circuit / paddock and facilities clean and tidy.

PARENTS please keep a watchful eye on your children, All the circuits we visit have an open paddock policy which means anyone could be around the paddock area, please know where your children are at ALL times. As always scooters, Bikes etc, are banned from the paddock whilst the meeting is “live” this includes lunch times. Any one seen with a scooter, Push Bike etc, will have it confiscated and it will only be released with a £20 release fee that will go to a charity of our choice.

LICENCE

Members

We will continue to be permitted and licensed under Nora Sport for 2026.

If you have not already done so It is important that all members print and complete the application form sent to you on email and also attached to this driver pack.

Non Members

You will need to fill in a one event License application form (guest) form at the end of this pack and hand in when signing on at scrutineering.

SIGN ON / TECHNICAL INSPECTION

You must attend technical inspection first thing in the morning, Saturday if doing both days or Sunday if just doing Race day.

If you have been inspected Saturday, you do not have to attend inspection on Sunday.

This is important to make sure that your equipment and machine meet the necessary basic regulations for racing with the UK Kart Series.

When attending Scrutineering you will need to also to do a “physical sign on”.

Digital scrutineering is open and you must enter your tyres using the alpha system.

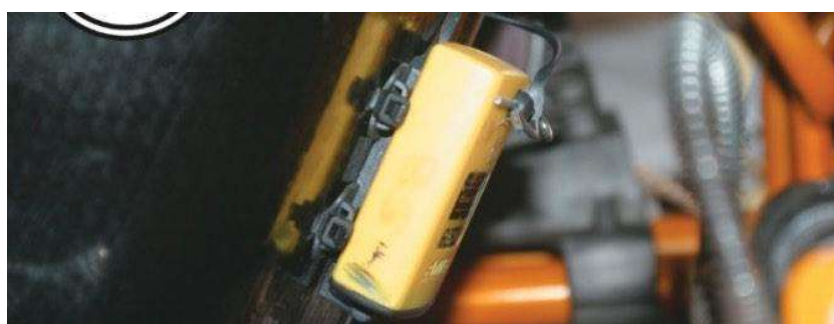
Please ensure you use the full barcode and upper case letters. The number must be exactly as it is on the tyre.

Once you have been inspected and your kart checked you will be issued with an inspection pass sticker. Failure to obtain and display the inspection pass on the vehicle will result in you not being able to take to the circuit.

HIRE TRANSPONDERS

Those that have hired and paid for transponders for the event, please collect these from the timing office between 11.30 and 1pm. **YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE EITHER A CREDIT CARD / DRIVING LICENCE OR £40 CASH DEPOSIT**, this will be returned to you at the end of the weekend when the transponder is returned.

if you finish early, please remember to hand them into either the scrutineering team or race control before you leave.



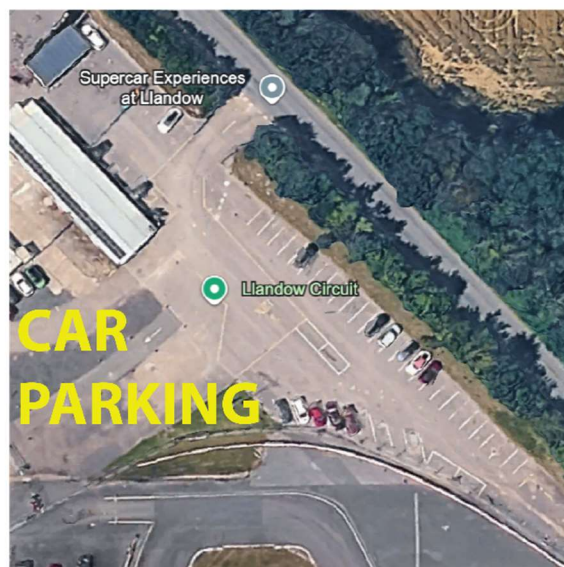
The Transponder must be mounted to the rear face of the seat in a position that is 25cm (+/- 5cm) above the track surface. There should be no physical obstacle between the Transponder and the Track Surface i.e., a clear line of site to the track.

**** Transponders **MUST** be fitted in all sessions after lunch on Saturday****

Paddock Area / Pit Bays

Llandow has no marked bays, we will operate on a first come first served basis. Some areas marked in red on the plan below will be reserved for the key holder, bigger team awnings and sponsors. Please keep these areas clear, until they have setup.

Please park all personal cars in the car park area by the entrance gate and keep the paddock free for vans and awnings.



RUNNING SCHEDULE

A running order / schedule is included at the back of this driver pack.

Please bring a copy of this with you so you are aware of how the day will run and also have an idea of when you will be out on circuit for your sessions.

It's worth remembering that this is a guide only and is based on a best-case scenario and we may well be running in front or behind this schedule due to circumstances beyond our control such as long red flag incidents etc.

We will endeavour to keep to this schedule as closely as possible, but it is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to make sure you are aware of what is out on circuit at any given time and also when you are due to be in the holding area / dummy grid and aim to be there at least 5 mins before your session is due to start.

LIVE TIMING / RESULTS

GRIDDING UP

Please be in the holding area in plenty of time before each of your session starts (see the event timetable for more details). After qualifying, please make sure that you are aware of your grid position for your classes and make sure you are in the holding area in plenty of time to take up your position on the dummy grid. This will speed up the whole gridding up process, minimise delays and keep the day flowing smoothly.

DIGITAL DRIVER SIGN ON.

We have incorporated a written driver briefing in with the declaration sign on and any additional important information that we need to pass on to drivers on the day will be broadcast over the Loudspeaker system (if available) and also using the Alpha Racehub and whatsApp group.

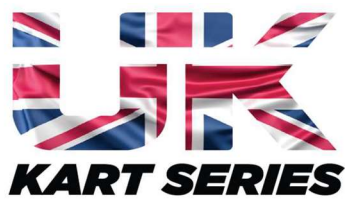
