HKRC SEPTEMBER 2026 CLUB MEETING – ROUND 7

Please take the time to read the following important information. These reminders are for everyone's benefit and will help ensure the meeting runs safely and smoothly.

START TIME

Track start time: 10:00 AM on both days.

Please make sure you are organised and have all the appropriate paperwork, licences, Parent/Guardian documentation, etc., ready when checking in on Saturday morning.

If you are attending Saturday practice, or are not doing the practice day, please make sure you have signed on online.

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED ON SITE

Please be reminded that no scooters, bikes, footballs, etc. are to be brought onto the site.

WILLOWS PADDOCK & PARKING

Please park sensibly and considerately to ensure there is enough room for everyone.

Motorhomes must park to the left-hand side of the portacabin when looking towards the track.

Under no circumstances should vehicles be parked on the road leading into Willows Paddock.

No motorhomes are to be parked in the grass car park outside the paddock.

Please keep off the bank around Willows.

Please do not leave tyres at the circuit. Too many tyres are being left behind, which is costing the club money that could otherwise be invested back into the club. Please take your tyres home with you.

KART COLLECTION & WALKWAY SAFETY

We have previously experienced a Health & Safety issue around the walkway used by people pushing karts to the grid. Vehicles have been parked in this area while people have attempted to collect karts from their awnings. You must wait until racing has finished before collecting any karts. Please follow this instruction to keep the walkway clear and everyone safe.

DOGS & GENERAL RULES

Dog owners, please be respectful and responsible while on site. We have had issues with dog waste being thrown into bushes and trees. If this continues, we will have no option but to ban dogs from the circuit. Please ensure you follow the General Rules and clean up after your dogs appropriately.

SCRUTINEERING – ROTAX CADET & INTER CLASSES

Competitors in the Rotax Cadet and Inter classes must make sure they read the Special Bulletin under Scrutineering. A copy of the bulletin will also be available in the clubhouse.

Your cooperation helps us keep the meeting safe, organised and enjoyable for everyone, while also ensuring the club's funds can be invested back into the club.

Timetable of Events

- **FRIDAY 11th (Set up day)**
 - **Gates will open from 09:30**
 - Flood lights will be switched off from 22:00 or maybe sooner.
 - Anyone arriving after lights off must park on grass area near gate house and wait until staff arrive on Saturday morning or park around the willows on the other side of circuit. **Please do not park in a pit bay in the main paddock unless you have booked it. When parking up please park sensibly to allow enough room for everyone and Ambulance access. There is no access to the track on set up day. Anyone found Parking in someone's pit bay will be moved.**
- **SATURDAY 12TH (Practice Day)**
 - Clubhouse open from 07:30 **for checking in and practice sticker & wristband allocation.**
 - First Practice will commence at 10.00 First group to be on grid for 09:50
- **SUNDAY 13TH (Race Day)**
 - Clubhouse open from 07:30 for checking in (only for those not attending on Friday)
 - Driver's briefing will be held on start finish line at approx. 09.15. Please remember it is mandatory for all drivers, PG license holders and team entrants to attend. At the discretion of the clerk of the course roll calls will be taken to ensure attendance.
 - Practice and Racing will commence at 10.00 each day. First session to be on grid for 09.50.

Parking / Paddock Safety

- **The main paddock area is exclusively for use by people with a pre-booked pit bays. Please do not park in one if you haven't booked it or found out from the club if it is available. Some people with annual pit bays only do the race day and turn up Friday afternoon or Saturday morning.** Additional pit space is available in the area around turn 1 and behind the willows. **For weekend Pit Bay availability please email hkrc.pitbays@gmail.com.**
- Only working vehicles are permitted in the paddock area and all working vehicles **MUST** be parked within the confines of your pit space.
- Annual pit bay holders please ensure you have collected your pass from Gate House on your way in and always display your pit pass.
- The roadways within the paddock area must be always kept clear to allow for emergency access. If at any time during the day a roadway is blocked the event will be stopped and will not resume until the roadway is clear. Please make sure you always park considerately.
- All other vehicles and spectator vehicles must be parked sensibly in the parking area to the right of the main gate along the tree line. At all times obeying any instructions given by HKRC officials.



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Signing On

- **Signing on will need to be completed via your Alpha account prior to the event.**
- Please ensure that your licence photographs are uploaded to your Alpha profile.
- Please ensure that your PG Licence and photographs are uploaded to your Alpha profile.
- All competitors and PG license holders will need to check in with race control on practice day.
- Anyone not checked in by 09.15 on Sunday that wasn't at practice will be withdrawn from the meeting.
- Keep an eye on emails from us on your Alpha account as these will be updates for the race weekend.

SPECIAL BULLETIN – SCRUTINEERING & TYRES

ROTAX CADET & MINI INTER / INTER CLASSES – REAR SPROCKETS

Due to the current confusion surrounding rear sprockets in the **Rotax Cadet and Inter classes**, and in the spirit of sporting fairness, the club will mandate the use of **controlled rear sprockets** in these classes.

The standard **80T sprocket with seal** will be available from Scrutineering.

The sprocket used by each competitor must match the controlled component in **every way**, including **thickness**. The only exceptions are:

- Colour
- Relief holes

Any sprocket that does not match the controlled component in all other respects will not be permitted.

TYRE BARCODE SCANNING

Tyre barcodes will need to be scanned during **Saturday morning**.

Please take your tyres to **Scrutineering** for scanning during **Friday or Saturday**.

For nominated classes, **slick and wet tyres** must be left in the **Scrutineering Tyre Bay** once they have been scanned. The relevant classes will be displayed on the notice board.

All drivers who are present on Saturday must have their race tyres scanned before the final practice session.

FRIDAY TYRE HAND-IN TIMES

- **Cadets:** 12:00 – 13:00
- **Mini Inter:** 13:00 – 14:00
- **Juniors:** 14:00 – 15:00

WET TYRE REQUIREMENT

For this month's meeting, competitors in the following classes must also nominate **one set of wet tyres** to be:

1. Scanned for the meeting.
2. Placed in the **Scrutineering Tyre Bay**.

This applies to:

- Cadet classes
- Rotax Mini Inter
- Junior

SAFETY CHECKS – FRIDAY

Our Scrutineering Team will be conducting **safety checks throughout Friday**.

If a member of the Scrutineering Team has not yet seen your kart, please let them know so that the necessary checks can be completed.

PERSONAL SAFETY EQUIPMENT

As required by **MSUK**, you must now also have the following checked before Practice:

- Helmet
- Race suit
- Gloves
- Boots

Please ensure these items are presented for inspection before you go out on track.

SCRUTINEERING FORMS – ALPHA SYSTEM

Scrutineering forms for **all classes** must be completed on the **Alpha system**.

All forms MUST be completed by 09:30 on Sunday.

Failure to complete the required forms by this deadline **may result in a fine**.

If you have any difficulty completing the forms, please speak to the **Chief Scrutineer before 09:30 on Sunday morning**.

TRANSPONDER CHECKS – SATURDAY

Please attach your **transponder for the final two sessions on Saturday** so that checks can be carried out.

NOSECONE CHECKS – RACE DAY

A **traffic-light system** will be in place for nosecone checks on race day.

When the **red light is displayed, please remain seated**.

Do not get out of your kart until the **green light** is displayed.

Please follow the traffic-light system at all times to help the checks run safely and efficiently.

Please make sure you read and understand all of the above requirements before arriving at the meeting.

Your cooperation will help Scrutineering run efficiently and ensure the meeting is conducted safely and fairly for everyone.

General

RACE FORMAT

- All classes will run **Practice, 3 Heats and a Final**.
- **All classes will run in accordance with the 2026 NCR regulations.**

SCALES

Scales will be **closed during the Sunday morning Practice session**.

If you wish to check your weight, please do so **before your Practice session commences**.

OFFICIALS & INSTRUCTIONS

At all times while on site, please follow the instructions given by **HKRC or Motorsport UK officials**.

If you are unsure about anything, please ask a member of the **HKRC Team**.

ENGINE STARTING

Engines may be started in the **Assembly Area**, but **excessive revving is strictly prohibited**.

Failure to follow this instruction may result in the matter being **reported to the Steward of the Meeting**.

Where possible, we would prefer competitors to start their engines on the **Dummy Grid once the kart is on the ground**. This helps us to minimise noise and maintain good relations with our neighbours.



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The only exception is where you have permission from the **Chief Scrutineer** to do otherwise.

RESPECT FOR OUR NEIGHBOURS

Please be respectful to our neighbours in the surrounding villages.

Please observe all speed limits at all times.

DOGS

Dogs must be kept **securely within your awning space**.

Dogs must **not** be walked:

- In the fields surrounding the track
- On the track
- In the paddock area

The only permitted area for walking dogs is **outside the paddock towards the road gate**.

Please clean up after your dog and dispose of waste appropriately.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Please make sure that you are familiar with and follow the club's **Supplementary Regulations** at all times.

TRACK WALKS

Track walks are permitted **only on Saturday and Sunday mornings prior to Practice and racing**.

RUBBISH & WASTE

Rubbish bins will be situated in the **cages around the Main Paddock and Willows Paddock**. These will be the main collection points for rubbish during the weekend.

We will also have someone going around with bin bags. These can be:

- Left outside your awning during the day, or
- Taken to the designated collection point.

If you are missed, please contact **Race Control** and ask for a bin bag.

TYRES

DO NOT leave tyres at the circuit.

All tyres must be taken away with you.

WILLOWS Paddock & LAND DRAINS

Please be aware of the **land drains at the bottom of the bank around Willows**. These have been in place for some time but can present a hazard. The **bank around Willows Paddock is out of bounds**.

KEEP OFF THE BANK.

Please do not climb, walk or play on the bank.

ENTRIES

During busy months, **entries will be available to club members first for a period of 10 days**.

Entries open on the **Monday preceding the last meeting**.

Please ensure you are aware of the relevant entry opening dates.

UPDATES & COMMUNICATION

If there are any updates to this information, they will be posted on the **noticeboard in the clubhouse** and/or communicated via **social media**.

Additional information may also be sent to you through your **Alpha account or the HKRC App**.

Please make sure your contact details and notifications are kept up to date.

RESPECT FOR THE HKRC SITE & FACILITIES

Anyone reported, seen or caught **tampering with or damaging any part of the HKRC site** will be dealt with accordingly.

Everyone visiting the circuit must treat the facilities and surrounding areas with respect.

The bank around Willows Paddock is strictly out of bounds – KEEP OFF.

TOILETS & PORTALOOS

Please keep all toilets **clean and tidy**.

This includes cleaning up after yourself when using:

- Hand basins
- Cubicles
- Toilets

Please leave the facilities in a condition that you would expect to find them.

PORTALOOS

Portaloos are situated around the site.

DO NOT park in front of the portaloos around Willows.

DO NOT empty motorhome/mobile-home waste into the disabled portaloo by the clubhouse or into any other Portaloo on site.

Please use the appropriate waste disposal facilities.

CLUB CONTACT & COMMUNICATION

Hunts Kart Racing Club is run and organised by volunteers in their spare time. We all have **full-time jobs**, so please be patient when waiting for replies to emails.

Please **do not use the general information email address for entry or membership enquiries**. A large number of emails can end up in spam, which is not checked regularly, and your enquiry may therefore not be answered in time for the meeting.
